I have included a copy of my child’s recent tetanus vaccination. I agree that on behalf of myself, my child, my heirs, personal representatives and executors, I release, discharge, indemnify, and hold harmless the Houston Humane Society, its agents, employees, officers, contractors and board of directors, from any and all claims, causes of action, or demands, if any, in connection with the same, based on damages or injuries which may be incurred or sustained by me or said child in any way connected with said child’s participation in Companion Camp activities or with said child’s presence on the Houston Humane Society premises including, but not limited to, animal bites, accidents, or injuries. I also understand that said child is to remain on the Houston Humane Society property for the duration of the activities. If my child leaves the property during participation, with or without permission of a staff member, I release, indemnify, and hold harmless the Houston Humane Society for any and all personal injury and property damages resulting from said child leaving the Houston Humane Society property. I give the Houston Humane Society authority to seek emergency medical treatment for said child. I know of no medical or other condition that would prevent said child from participation in activities at the Houston Humane Society. I grant the right to photograph, reproduce and use said child’s artwork, written work, picture, silhouette, and other reproductions of physical likeness in connection with the Houston Humane Society.

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
