

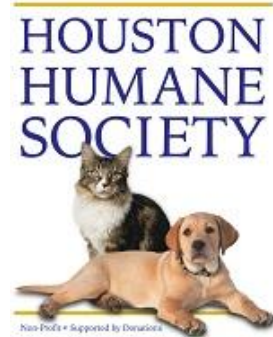

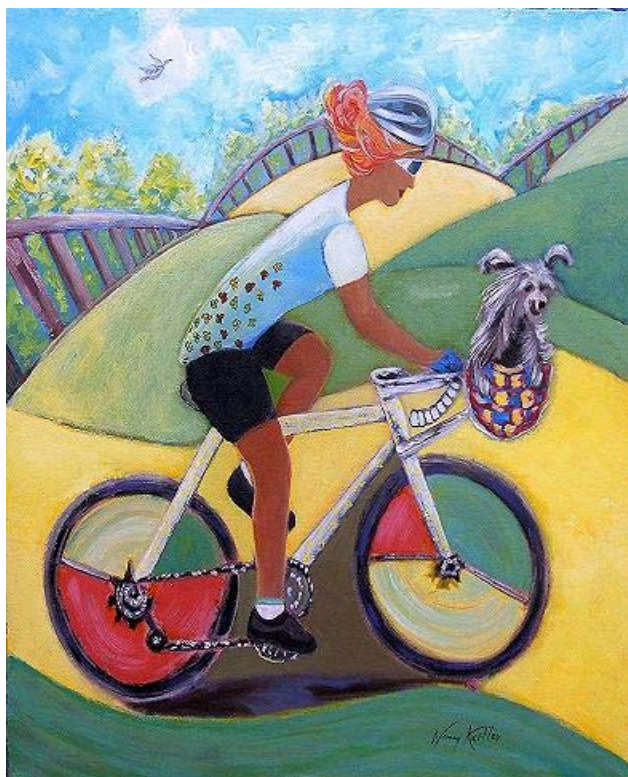

"Second Chances" is Archway Gallery's annual juried exhibition which will once again, benefit the Houston Humane Society. The exhibition will be on display from July 3 through August 5, 2010. And mark your calendars for

an grand opening reception on July 10, from 5-8 pm. It's open to the public.

Jeff Law, the owner and director of October Gallery, a prestigious art space located in The Heights, is the exhibition juror. For more than 20 years, Law presented the work of both fine and folk artists with a unique global prespective at his gallery.

The works of approximately 30 artists will be on display during the exhibit, with one being awarded a \$500 prize for "Best of Show". The winning artist's work will also be awarded a one month exhibit at Archway Gallery during its 2011 season.

Forty-percent of the sale of each artwork during the exhibition will be donated directly to the Houston Humane Society to help us continue our ongoing battle against animal abuse, neglect and pet overpopulation.
