Houston Humane Society gets creative to help find more animals a forever home this May

Houston, TX: The Houston Humane Society (HHS) announces “Chihuahua” de Mayo, a new adoption program aimed at helping homeless Chihuahua and Chihuahua mixes 6 months of age and older find new homes for Cinco de Mayo. Kicking off Sunday, May 1st and lasting until Sunday, May 15th, an extra special adoption price of just \$50 will be offered to help all Chihuahua and Chihuahua mixes find their forever home.

Despurrate Housecats are not to be forgotten! Things are heating up on *Whiskerteria* Lane, and every cat is feeling a bit crowded. For the entire month of May all felines will have a special 2 for 1 adoption fee of \$50 .

All adoptions at the Houston Humane Society include spay/neuter surgery, microchip, routine vaccinations, general health exam, rabies vaccine, de-worming, heartworm test in dogs over 6 months and feline leukemia test in cats, and an adoption kit.

About the HHS: The Houston Humane Society is a private, non-profit animal welfare organization dedicated to ending cruelty, abuse and the overpopulation of animals. The HHS does NOT receive any government funding or operating funds from national animal welfare organizations, and relies solely on donations, special events and program services.
