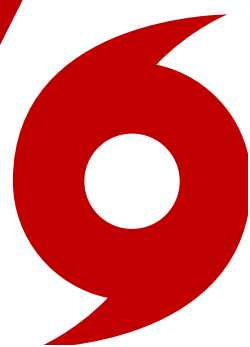


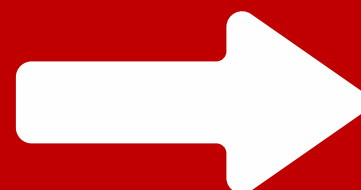

Having a plan in place saves time and reduces stress during emergencies. It helps you act quickly and keep everyone—people and pets—safe.

## Know Your Risks -

Understand your area's hurricane threats and evacuation zones.

## Make a Family Plan -

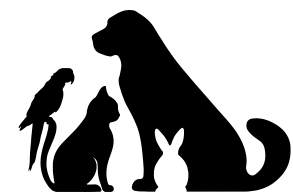
Decide where to go, how to communicate, and what everyone's role is.

## Include Pets -

Plan for pet-friendly shelters or hotels and pack a pet emergency kit.

## Stay Informed -

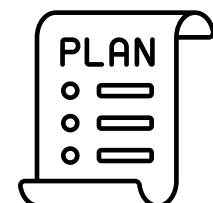
Sign up for local alerts and keep a battery-powered radio handy.

## Practice Your Plan -

Run through your plan with your family so everyone knows what to do.



# BUILD A KIT

An emergency evacuation kit for your pet ensures they have food, water, medications, & comfort items ready to go. It saves time during an evacuation & helps keep your pet safe, healthy, and less stressed in a crisis.



**\*Important Documents**  
medical records, microchip #



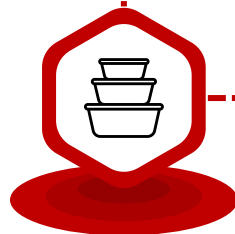
**Fresh supply of food & water**  
2 weeks worth



**Cleaning Supplies**  
potty pads, disposal bags etc.



**Favorite Toys or Blankets**  
help keep stress low



**Portable Containers**  
for food, litter, meds, etc.



**Feeding & Med. Instructions**  
clear details for diet & schedule

## Pet Emergency Preparedness Checklist



### DOCUMENTS

- Microchip: Ensure your pet's microchip is registered/updated
- Vet records (vaccination records, rabies vaccine number, etc.)
- Research pet-friendly accommodations
- Rabies certificate
- Recent & clear pet photos



### NECESSITIES

- 2 week supply of food/litter
- 2 week supply of water (bottled water)
- Portable bowls (for food & water), litter box
- Feeding Instructions: Provide details about your pet's specific diet & feeding schedule.
- 2 week supply of medication & clear instructions



### ESSENTIALS

- Waterproof containers, sealable Ziploc bags
- Collar with IDs (updated contact information)
- Pet carrier (appropriate size; your pet should be able to turn around comfortably in the carrier)
- Cleaning supplies (paper towels, canine potty pads, disposal bags, & disinfectant)
- Favorite toys or blankets

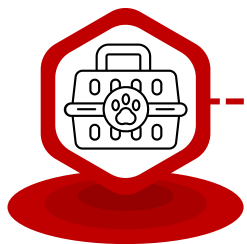

Houston Humane Society partners with Petco Love Lost to make reuniting lost pets easier using image recognition technology to search a national lost and found database.



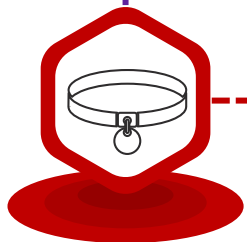
## Secure the pet

Keep them safe & separated from your own pets.



## Search Petco Love Lost

Upload a photo to **Petco Love Lost** to find a match in the national database.



## Check for ID

Look for tags or contact info.



## Scan for Microchip if this option is available

Most vets, shelters, or animal services can do this for free.



## Report & share

Create a "Found Pet" listing and share on social media, Nextdoor, Craigslist.



## Document everything

Take notes and photos in case the owner reaches out.
